OAKLAND DRESSING ROOM--TOM FLORES, HEAD COACH

"It is pretty obvious, we are not getting the ball into the end zone. It is always a bad day when you get blown off the field, but we are all professionals. We have got to prepare ourselves to fight back. Our backs are REALLY up against the wall now. We have got to fight back. If changes need to be made, then we will make changes. Our running game right now is just not going at all. We are in a position where our offense is predictable right now and when you get into that position, they (the opponents) can really tee off on you.
