CHICAGO DRESSING ROOM (Neill Armstrong, Head Coach)

"It seemed like another San Diego game (a game the Bears won on an overtime field goal by Roveto, just two weeks ago). We came into the game with a lot of respect for Kansas City, in fact the same amount of respect we had for San Diego. Although, the Chiefs are not as flamboyant as San Diego, the way the Chargers throw the ball, and this is not an after game comment, we entered the week worried about Kansas City.

This is the best that our defense has played all year. I don't ~~know~~ know that the stats were but this best effort we have given all season. It was very tough to pass today. I never did see what a dry ball looked like all day. We did however plan on running the ball a lot today.

(On the unsportsmanship penalty against Gary Green on the field goal attempt) "I have never seen that called before. However, we noticed in the films this week that they (Chiefs) have been doing it all season. We tipped off the officials just before the play (to watch for the vaulting). They (the officials) were watching for it.

Game balls were awarded to: Mike Singletary; Al Harris; and John Roveto.

(Injury report on Walter Payton)--He has a pain above his knee and below his thigh on his right leg according to Coach Neill Armstrong. "They will know more about it tomorrow but I don't think it is that serious and it seems not to have anything to do with the knee itself."

KANSAS CITY DRESSING ROOM (Marv Levy, Head Coach)

(On the penalty against the Chiefs on the first field goal attempt in the overtime) "He (Gary Green) jumps up in the air as high as he can jump. He tries to get over (the top. That's what we did when we blocked the earlier one. He (the official) said Gary stepped up onto an offensive lineman. No, not on his own man. If you step on them, yeah, it's a penalty. We teach them to go up as high as they can, over the middle. I did not see it. It's pretty difficult not too, I guess.

The weather did not lose the game for us. They did not have any turnovers in the ball game, which is very good for them (the Bears). It was a difficult day to handle the ball, but they (Bears) did not fumble the ball. They did a very good job of protecting the ball and not fumbling. We were not counting on them to fumble to win the game. They (the fumbles) contributed, certainly, and took us away from several scoring opportunities. (

(On the quart erbacks and their status) "I don't know. It's too quick all of a sudden to talk about our personnel plans when you still feel badly about losing. I purposely pushed that out of my mind for the moment. Neither of the three quarterbacks who played, did very well or were productively. (On the switch to Fuller) "We were not moving the ball very well and I figured it would perk us up and might have an effect. It seemed like the logical move to make.

(On the Bears) " I felt ther were going to be difficult to move the ball against. And they were. We have a lot of respect for them and going in. We probably would have had more success if we had not turned it over so much. We might have made for yardage. We can't keep expecting the defense to stop them. We needed to do more offensively to win the game.

The fumbles, remember, were not all by the backs, two were by the quarterbacks and one, a real tough one, by J.T. Smith on a punt return. That one came at the toughest time with the weather at its worst. That is the first time this year that J. T. has fumbled and ~~is~~ probably only the second time since he has been with the Chiefs.
