JACK PATERA, SEATTLE HEAD COACH

"The thing that stands out the most today was when the defense came out in the second half ready to play and the Chiefs had that long drive for the touchdown. After that first drive in the second half we did a very poor job defensively. They blew us away the remainder of the ball game. After a disaster like we had in the closing minutes (Burruss' interception for the touchdown) of the first half, you know that you have to play good defense to have a chance. You can give Kansas City all the credit which they justly deserve, but I thought it was a very poor effort on our part.

When we came out to start the second half, I felt that we could correct some things, like our blocking and our timing. I felt good about us getting back into the game. We had to come out and score point and we had to come out and stop them.

They (Chiefs) did not do anything today that they had done previously. We were more fearful of what they would do with Delaney and that's not to say that Hadnot is not a quality player, but just check his stats today.

(About the Chiefs) "They looked very good today. They are a good solid football team. They look much better now than they did the first time we met. Bill Kenney is a much ~~improved~~ improved quarterback. He did a great job today.

(On the performance of the running back--MARV ~~LEWIS~~ (LEVY) "We only have four of them. They all ran well and did a good job of carrying the ball, including Curtis (Bledsoe) when he was in there near the end. I am very pleased with all of them. None of the four has been in the league more than a year. Billy Jackson has risen to the occasion every time we have had him in there and he did again today. Also, our offensive line did a very good job of blocking.

"I think it was our most effective performance offensively, we were very effective. Bill (Kenney) hit on 17 of 22 for some key yardage. This was certainly our most consistent game. They (Seattle) moved the ball very well in the first half ~~and~~ too.

(On no turnovers) "I really don't know that to attribute it to. There was a lot of ~~consciousness~~ consciousness ~~of~~ on the part of our players not to turn it over.

(On Bill Kenney's performance) "Bill's had some good performances in the past. He had a great one at Baltimore and a great one against Denver last year. And in the first Seattle game he played well too. It (today's game) certainly ranks right up there. Yes, I think people expect too much out of every quarterback, they seem to think they (quarterbacks) operate in a vacuum.

(How important was Burruss' interception) "It was big. We got the ball with more than two minutes to play at 6-6, got a touchdown and then got another one right away with Burruss' play. I did not feel too good about things ~~though~~ though until, we got that fumble down at the two yard line.

"The big thing that helped us in the second half, thought our defense did play better too, was taking that opening kickoff, taking time off the clock, and going in for seven points. Our team was ~~made~~ aware that Seattle has come back before to win. They did it against Pittsburgh and last week against San Diego. Our players were, I think, very conscious of that ~~fact~~ fact.

(On the status of Henry Marshall) "It looks like he has a sprained knee that will keep him out for awhile. The doctor tells me he (Marshall) is probably going to be out for several weeks possible three-four weeks but that is not definite.
