MIAMI DRESSING ROOM - Don Shula, Head Coach

"This was the first step. We set out a long time ago to do things in stages, and we have accomplished one of those stages by reaching the playoffs. We still have a big game remaining next week against Buffalo. We felt we had to get it done today. It's first things first. We wanted to clinch it in Kansas City. We did not exactly take it to them offensively, however our defense was outstanding. They (defense) really did the job keeping them off the boards after that first touchdown. At times it was not very pretty, we just could not put it away in the fourth quarter. It is a good feeling to know that we are in the playoffs."

(Why he put Strock in at quarterback): "We were struggling on offense, and we had some good opportunities. Strock had been playing well coming into the game and after those two interceptions he really got us going today."

(On Orosz's fake punt run) "We had a delayed punt on and no one came in at him so he just went on his own. It was a very heads-ups play for a rookie."

INJURIES: "We had a couple of serious injuries...Don McNeal has a broken arm and Tony Nathan reinjured a previous rib problem. Also Eddie Hill got hurt on a play late in the game, he got pushed back and injured his ankle. Bob Baumhower was out for awhile and I really do not know the extent of his injury."

KANSAS CITY CHIEFS - Marv Levy, Head Coach

(On the errant snap from center on field goal attempt by Rudnay; asked if Rudnay practiced deep snaps much) "Some, but not a great deal. We get as much as we can in team practice for Todd Thomas. He (Rudnay) practices as much as he can. He (Rudnay) has not done it in a game for I don't know how long. He practices but it makes a difference in experience in a game. God knows, he did not want to do it. He feels awful about it. The only way not to do something like that is to not walk out there to attempt it again. I know Rudnay well enough that he will walk back out there and attempt it again. The only defeat he would need to take is to not walk back out there and attempt it."

(On the loss of Delaney) "The loss at least hamstring your ability to run the ball as well. Yes, it affected what we did. You think more about passing and finding ways to move the ball. Yes, it affects your not being able to run the ball well."

(On the final play of the first half) Yes, it would have made a difference (to score the touchdown) Our attitude was okay coming out (in the second half), I thought. It's a lift in getting a score. Would it have been great to score--Yes. Would it have made a difference--~~Yes, it would have made a difference~~ Yes. Did it lose the game for us--No.

(On his feelings about losing the second straight game after the team put out a good effort) "Sure, it's frustrating. Frustrating goes with losing. I thought they played hard. We just did not click on enough things offensively by a long shot."
