QUOTES FROM LOS ANGELES COACH TOM FLORES

"Those are the type of games championship teams have to win. We knew Kansas City would be tough. There is no way they should be a 1-5 team. They are tough defensively and we knew it would be a tough game."

On the game winning touchdown: "Calvin Muhammad made a great catch. We were trying to get closer to put us in better position for a field goal but Jim (Plunkett) thought he could get it to him and, again, Calvin made a great catch. I sent in a play that was intended just to get us closer but Jim felt he could get it to him. The ball was not thrown perfectly but Calvin did the job."

"It was a great game. I'm sorry so many people missed it. This was quite a change. This has been a great rivalry and we're use to coming in here and playing before a large and loud crowd."

On the matchup between Cliff Branch and Trent Bryant: "When they have a guy like Gary Green on one side and a young guy on the other it's pretty obvious where you want to go. That is particularly true when we have Cliff Branch on that side."

"We really didn't play very well but Kansas City had a lot to do with that. It was a game of big plays. The biggest was probably at the end when Gary Barbaro appeared to have made an interception and Todd Christensen stripped him of the ball. Without that it's a different outcome."

KANSAS CITY DRESSING ROOM: COACH MARV LEVY

(Asked if this loss makes him feel worse than any of the others) "Every defeat is bad. It (this one) is because it's now. I felt miserable after the last three and I do now."

(On the winning TD catch) "I did not see it. I was at the other end of our bench and the play went out of my sight. I really did not see the catch."

(On performance of his team) "Yeah, I thought they played more tuned in to the idea they were playing football and everything else was behind them. They tried to muster that in the past, but they were more successful this time."

There was no turning point. When the game goes down to the last 30 seconds. I would have liked to score in some of the other instances. It did not look like the kind of a game that was going to be blown open at any time. We should have scored more than we did.

(On QB change) "I just decided to make the change. He (Fuller) was under a lot of pressure and I said before that I would make a change if we needed to change the tempo of our offense and I thought we did. (Made a change) Our offensive tempo did change when Kenney came in. (Asked if that change would continue next week) "I have not even thought about the quarterback situation yet. Who is starting at quarterback is the least thing on my mind right now. I will make the decision I think I ought to make, and I don't consider a lot of other things."

(On Trent Bryant's interference call) "I did not think so. They threw one of those 50-yard flags and it is just unbelievable to me. Its a rule, so they can call it, but I think descretion has to be used in the application of it. Three touchdowns were scored as a result of pass interference calls. It boggles my mind, the way pass interference is called. It helped us on our go ahead TD too, it is a ludicrous rule."

"We did not cash in on enough opportunities. We would have been fine if we had won. We certainly have to produce more when we get those opportunities."

(Asked if there was panic over giving up so many sacks) "No, there is no panic. What good would panic do? If panic would help, I would panic."
