KANSAS CITY CHIEFS VS. SAN DIEGO CHARGERS

DAN HENNING, CHARGERS HEAD COACH

"I think that some of the effort these guys have been putting out in practice came through today. We played a good, all around football game. We had to get some of the running game going. Tim (Spencer) and Marion (Butts) and those guys in front of them did a good job. Five turnovers for them and none for us. That's the way to win in the NFL."

RE: Ilesic's shoes....."We had an unusual situation before the game. We got Henry Ilesic in here and he didn't have any shoes. We bought him some shoes and when he came out to kick before the game the officials said he altered the shoe. He made no attempt to alter the shoe, and it is something we will have to get a ruling on. We were under the impression that if you buy the thing (the shoe) and you don't do anything to it, you can wear it. They didn't allow him to use it (the shoe)."

ON ROD BERNSTINE....."He is not real flashy and he's got an unusual running style. He's kind of a nifty runner for a big guy. He has a way of making guys miss. He catches the ball well, he runs the ball well and he is really coming on."

RE: THE CHARGERS WIN...."When you sit at home and draw it up, that's the way you like it to happen. No turnovers for us, and lots of turnovers for them. You get out of trouble with your kicking game like we did today and that is the way you want it to come out."

MORE ON ILESIC....."Yes, under the condition, if it hadn't been for the whole shoe situation I think he did a good job. He hit a couple of big ones and he had the one punt go into the end zone real close to the one yard line."

VENCIE GLENN

ON THE ^{DEFENSE} ~~DEFENSE~~..... "The pass rush was phenomenal. The secondary went along with them and played great too. We played man to man and went after them. DeBerg was rattled. He was watching the side where he was going to throw to... it seemed like he was telegraphing his passes. The defensive line never allowed him to get into a ~~system~~ ^{rhythm}."

ON HIS INTERCEPTION...."The pass rush was excellent. Elvis (Patterson) did a great job hanging on to his receiver. The ball was tipped and it just went right into my hands."

LEE WILLIAMS

"We put forth the same amount of effort we have in the past. It just seemed today we executed better. We rattled (Steve) DeBerg."

RE: CHRISTIAN OKOYE....."I wasn't really concerned about him. He had one big run and we corrected it and we got after him. He did nothing else."

JAMES FITZPARTICK

ON THE CHARGERS DEFENSE.... "I can't say enough for the defense. It is very uplifting for the offense when they make big plays like those interceptions. They kept Kansas City's offense off the field and let us stay on it."

KANSAS CITY CHIEFS VS. SAN DIEGO CHARGERSCOACH MARTY SCOTTENHEIMER

(RE: INTERCEPTIONS) It's tough to overcome that, but you have to find a way to do it. ... I don't care if you throw five interceptions or eight interceptions, you have to find a way to stop it. In all candor, you can't turn it over that many times and win. ... We didn't play as well as we're capable. San Diego deserves the credit, though. They played a great game. ... I would say we didn't play efficient, tough football ... We made too many errors. ... Five interceptions can be offset if you go make some plays elsewhere. (RE: NOT RUNNING OKOYE ON FIRST AND GOAL FROM 9 FOLLOWING OKOYE'S 60-YD RUN) He just ran 60 yards. We felt he needed a blow. We took him out. Jim Saxon has done a good job running the ball in the last couple of weeks. And so has Herman (Heard).

20 - DERON CHERRY - FS

(RE: K.C.'S POOR PLAY AT START OF SECOND HALF) You have to come out with the same tempo that you finished the first half with. They came out with better tempo and ran some good draw plays. The first three minutes of the first half and the first three minutes of the second half are ~~always~~ always key times. (RE: HIS OPINION OF MCMAHON'S PLAY TODAY) He didn't do anything that impressed me.

17 - STEVE DEBERG - QB

(RE: S.D.'S DEFENSE) They were doing a lot of things differently, in particular, their front, to stop our running game. They changed a lot. And they did a good job at it. ... We were trying to adjust. We didn't do a very good job of it. I'm sure the way I played didn't help much. ... I was throwing the ball high. ... I just played bad; that was the main thing. ... I am concerned with our early mistakes. It's a problem I'm going to have to take care of. They (S.D.) changed their defensive alignment and basically went to a seven-man front. That surprised us at first. We tried going bootleg, and that didn't work. ... They really surprised us. It was a good job of defensive planning on their part. ... I was not throwing the ball well deep, to our wide receivers. (DID ANYTHING ELSE CONTRIBUTE TO THE FIVE INTERCEPTIONS OTHER THAN S.D.'S DEFENSIVE FRONT?) Yeah, bad throws. My main thing is not to let interceptions happen early in the game. ... (AGAIN, RE: THE INTERCEPTIONS) We didn't throw toward (Sam) Seale, did we, hardly? Maybe we should have. (DO YOU THINK YOU MAY NOT HAVE BEEN "LOOKING OFF" THE MAIN RECIEVER?) You can only analyze that when you look at the films. But I don't think that was a factor. (DID THE S.D. DBS DO ANYTHING TO CONFUSE YOU -- THAT MAY HAVE LED TO THE INTERCEPTIONS?) It was their front seven that made the difference.

8 - NICK LOWERY - K

(RE: MESS) I just gotta learn to hit the ball left of center. The only time I miss the ball, it seems to go right. I just didn't make it, pure and simple.

AMES FITZPATRICK

ON THE PLAY OF THE CHARGERS... "This game was very positive. Hopefully we will continue it and get on a roll."

BILL BYRD

ON THE DEFENSE.... "The key was the pass rush. The down linemen did a great job of rattling DeBerg and making him throw when he didn't want to. Down linemen should get the rewards for the defensive play."
