# DAN HENNING, CHARGERS HEAD COACH

"I think that some of the effort these guys have been putting out in practice came through today. We played a good, all around football game. We had to get some of the running game going. RE: THE CHARGERS WIN.... "When you sit at home and draw it up, that's the way you like it to happen. No turnovers for us, and lots of turnovers for them. You get out of trouble with your kicking game like we did today and that is the way you want it to come out."

DBs DO ANYTHING TO CONFUSE YOU -- THAT MAY HAVE LED TO THE INTER-CEPTIONS?) It was their front seven that made the difference.
